EDITORIAL.



NCE again in this first number of the academic year we are glad to welcome many new students.

We believe that they have done well in making St. Bartholomew's the hospital of their choice, for by so doing they have made themselves heirs of a great and ancient tradition. Of these traditions and of their

practical application in the rough-and-tumble of student life we do not speak, for Sir D'Arcy Power and Mr. Reginald M. Vick have chosen the subject for an address at an early meeting of the Abernethian Society.

New men will soon find that they have entered into a brotherhood none the less real because limited by few rules nor defined by the written word. If we dare speak to those beginning medicine we would say: Whatever you do let it be of your best. What you shall be depends upon what you are Work hard and play hard. Help the Hospital in every way your gifts and inclinations make possible.
