Charter to prevent and address racial harassment in medical education

Dear Professor Thornton

We are writing to thank you for signing up to and supporting the <u>BMA's charter</u> on preventing and effectively dealing with racial harassment in medical education.

As outlined in our letter dated 30 July 2020, we trust that all schools that sign up will implement the charter in a reasonable time period. Schools are accountable to their students for their progress on implementing the charter and we encourage you to publicise widely that you have signed up.
