

borough functions). Since the creation in 2000 of a new Greater London Authority, covering the former GLC area but with more limited powers, the boroughs now have powers intermediate between those of English unitary authorities and non-metropolitan districts within shire counties.

The City of London is administered by its own distinct body, the Corporation of London, which predates the London boroughs.

The word *borough* has cognates in virtually every Germanic language, as well as other Indo-European languages. For a fuller explanation, see under *borough*.
