

Vice-Principal Humanities and Social Sciences' Report to

Change of Faculty Structure

From December 2016 the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences will be changing its governance structure to include Heads of School in the Faculty Executive. This will ensure that good practice is recognised and shared across all Schools, whilst also facilitating collective responsibility and more effective communication.

A Vice-Principal's Group will meet weekly to discuss day to day operational issues within the Faculty and this group will report in to the new Faculty Executive.

Queen Mary Institute in the Social Sciences and Humanities (Q-ISSH)

The Institute is an ideas generating hub for the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences at Queen Mary University of London. The activity of the Institute will be focused each year on a thematic programme. The Institute will also be home to a dynamic group of visiting fellows (both junior and senior), whose research interests align with the annual thematic programme.
