Main Items Discussed

1. Committee Membership

The Chair confirmed that Dr Rhiannon Thompson has now left QMUL (and thus QMERC) due to her taking a career break. The Chair expressed her thanks, and that of all members, to Dr Thompson for her work and support of the Committee.

Dr Chrisantha Fernando also confirmed that he would be stepping down from QMERC, due to his taking up a new job in industry, and was thanked for his contribution.

2. QMERC Chairmanship
