1. Research

- New five-year £1.5bn Global Challenges Research Fund (GCRF) to "ensure UK science takes a leading role in addressing the problems faced by developing countries", funding rounds underway/planned.
- Government White Paper proposed creation of UK Research and Innovation from RCUK plus Innovate UK will administer REF and distribute QR funding.
- REF meetings with all Schools/Institutes held to start to collect information and review plans.
- Research information detailed study of REF income for each UoA for each output, impact case study etc. is being finalised.
- **Research Consultation Group** newly re-formed with one representative per School/Institute as a forum for discussing research matters.
- New Research Computing Board is being formed to monitor research needs.
- Research Equipment a new call for proposals via Faculties will be released in summer.
- Misuse of social media by those opposed to research results or topics call for confidential input to assess possible changes of policy and practice (contact eoresearch@qmul.ac.uk).
- Research Fish feedback being sent to RCUK.
- New Symplectic Elements upgrade. Open data requirements website.

2. Life Sciences

- Barts Health Trust has submitted their Strategic Outline Case on land redevelopment and should move to next stage of detailed discussions in June to finalise development timelines by the end of the year.
- **New Research Centres** replacing domains Genomic Health, Bioengineering, Mind in Society plus cross-cutting Computational Biology.
- Wellcome Trust proposal for five year grant of £2.5m matched by QMUL funding, being submitted mid July to support LS.
- LS supporting other areas of work Digital Health, Microbiome
- Programme of focussed **workshops** bringing clinicians and researchers together, starting June.
- Broadening of UG and PG programmes being promoted by Life Sciences in liaison with Schools/SMD.
- QMUL **Festival of Communities** 24th May-4th June.
- New staff: Eleanor Groves (Researcher Development), Yasmin Ahmed (Equality and Diversity).
- Insider perspective on the Wellcome Trust talks.
- Development of LS DTP by new PGR Lead Magda Osman (SBCS).
