Academic Regulations 2018-19 (minutes 2017.132-2017.56)

Further to Senate's approval of the <u>Academic Regulations for 2018-19</u> at the June 2018 meeting, some minor refinements were approved by Chair's action as follows:

- removal of references to QMUL;
- removal of the Queen Mary Model as this is not a regulatory matter;
- 2.97 'within the school' has been removed from the last sentence;
- 3.64 'unless there are extenuating circumstances' has been added to the first sentence

The Academic Regulations are currently under review and a first draft will be considered by Senate at the meeting in December 2018.

Professional Capability and Fitness to Practise Regulations (minute 2017.140)
