Courses for January 2020 – Places still available!

PD169: Recruitment & Interview Selection

In response to demand, additional sessions have been made available for this popular course. There are still places available on 13th January!

If you're recruiting, please make sure that your panel has been selected and you've checked they have training well in advance of the shortlisting and interview dates.

PD231: Sexual Violence Support Awareness Training

This session aims to help those working with victims of crime, specifically sexual violence, through increased understanding of the impacts and available support networks. It is particularly recommended to staff in HR and/or management roles, but is available to all staff.

PD224: Chairing Employment Panels Training for Managers

This will cover the key components of a chairing a hearing (e.g. disciplinary, grievance, appeal) and takes managers through the practicalities of managing and follow up to the hearing. This training will ensure the necessary elements are covered to underpin a fair and impartial decision-making process.

Recognition for Organisational & Professional Development

Last month, the Education Excellence Award and President and Principal's Prize 2019-20 was awarded to Patrick McGurk and Jamie Hilder, for their work on the **Third Sector Management Degree Apprenticeship.** This is the first degree apprenticeship of its type run in the UK.
