SEED PRIZES

We also have two SEED prizes:

- one for the students who received the SEED award (3 prize winners each academic year). This prize recognises the 3 best reflective applications on: (1) the experience of co-creation, (2) the impact of the project on the student co-creator and (3) contribution of the student work to the enhancement of teaching and learning across Queen Mary.
- one for Educators who endorsed/ participated in the project (3 prize winners each academic year); This prize for the most collaborative project recognises (1) the extent to which the educator has engaged co-creatively with the student and (2) the extent to which the co-creative activities have led to impact.

Nominations are made by the reviewers and winners are chosen in the Summer Panel.

All Prize winners receive a certificate, and the student SEED prize winners receive support to apply for International recognition (<u>SPIA – Student Partnership Impact Award</u>). alongside a £50 voucher.
