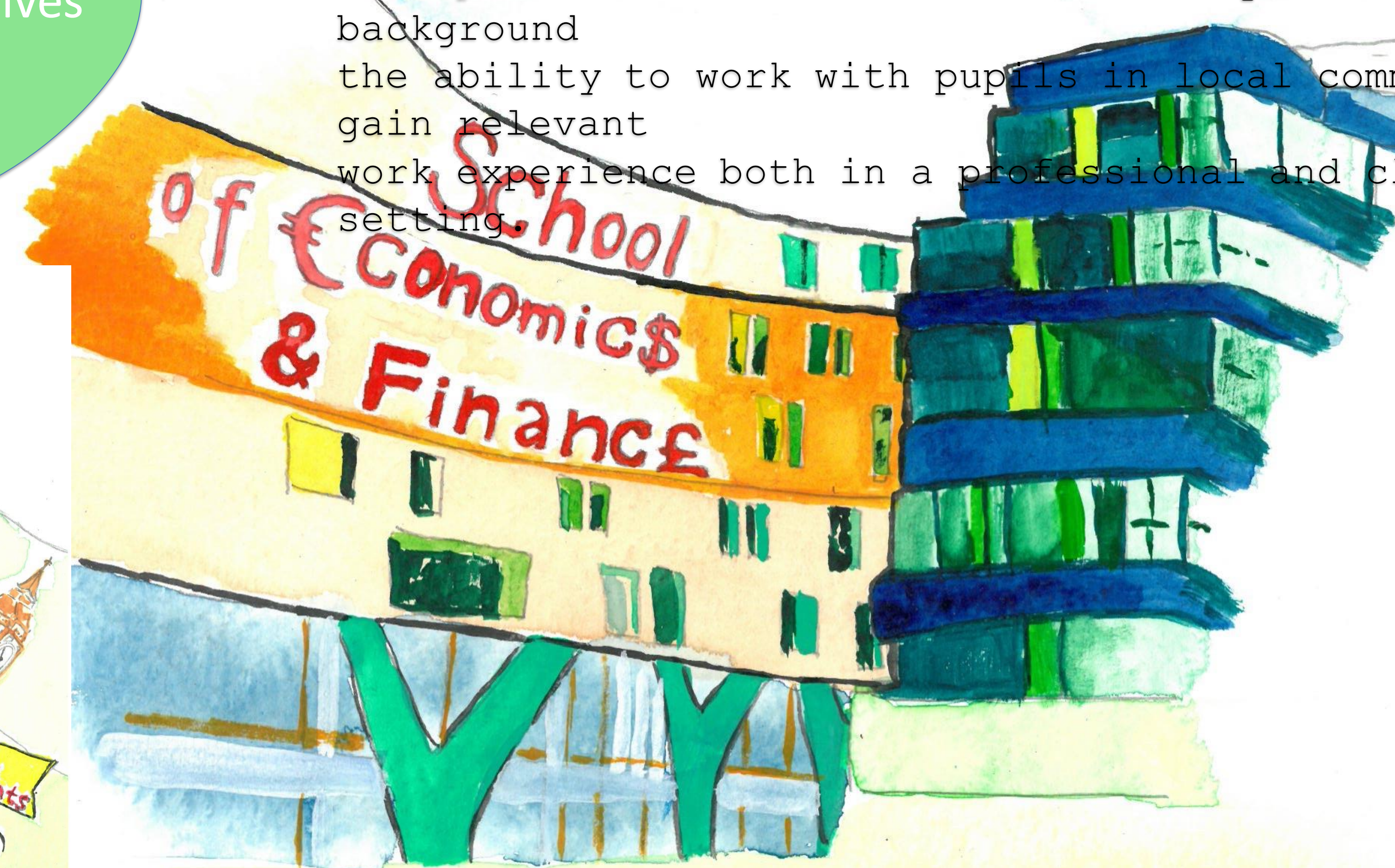
qNomics expansion into local schools, under the new scheme of **Young Entrepreneurs** allowed students to deliver **bespoke talks** about commercial awareness and entrepreneurship and run **mock business workshops**.

The workshops run with three local schools: **St. Paul's Way Trust School, Bishop Challoner Catholic Federation of Schools and George Green's School**.

Students participating in the scheme develop public speaking skills by delivering a presentation to pupils focusing on entrepreneurship. They also run a workshop in which they assist pupils setting up a mock business.

Students take up the role of 'professionals' themselves and in this context develop a wide range of analytical and transferrable skills.

This provided students with a **wider participation** background the ability to work with pupils in local communities and gain relevant work experience both in a professional and clinical setting.
